



Health Insurance for Everyone

Everyone in Washington can get health and dental insurance, regardless of immigration status.

Steps to apply

- Gather your information

You can apply for insurance online or in person with a navigator.

Washington Healthplanfinder checks your eligibility for federal and state programs, WA Health Path and savings. After getting your results, follow the on-screen instructions to select a plan and get enrolled.

How much does insurance cost?

The cost of insurance depends on many factors, including income, family size and where you live. Some people qualify for programs that lower monthly costs. A navigator can help you understand if there are programs available for you and how much you would have to pay each month. Cascade Care plans almost always offer the best coverage for your money.

Is my information private?

Your safety is important to us. Your information is only used to find the insurance plans and savings available for you. Washington Healthplanfinder does not share information for people without a federally recognized immigration status.

If you enroll in Apple Health (Medicaid), your information is handled by the Health Care Authority (HCA). Read more about HCA's privacy practices.

Recent updates

We monitor federal changes and Washington Healthplanfinder will notify you of anything that affects your insurance or savings.

Everyone in Washington can get health and dental insurance using Washington Healthplanfinder, including Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) recipients and people without a “federally recognized immigration status” (federally recognized immigration status).

Due to federal changes, DACA recipients should answer “No” (No) when asked if they are “lawfully present” (lawfully present) in their application.
