People with H-2A Visas Are Lawfully Present

H-2A visas are provided to non-immigrants who are approved to work in agriculture. If you have one, you are "lawfully present" in the U.S.

Health Insurance for People with H-2A Visas

If you have an H-2A visa and live in Washington, you can get insurance through Washington Healthplanfinder. However, you do not qualify for every program because of the visa's temporary status.

Programs You May Qualify for

Full-coverage health insurance

Cascade Care and other Qualified Health Plans cover doctor visits, hospital care, prescriptions, and more.

- Premium savings Cascade Care Savings and tax credits reduce the monthly cost of your health insurance plan.
- Limited coverage health care Some programs cover certain services or situations, like pregnancy, family planning, and emergency care.

Programs You Do Not Qualify for

Washington Apple Health

Apple Health is the name for Medicaid in Washington. People with H-2A visas do not qualify for Apple Health, except for Apple Health for Pregnant Individuals.
